Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank Schillari on Pedestrian Struck in Hoboken

JERSEY CITY, NJ - Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari regarding a pedestrian struck in Hoboken last week.

"Monday morning, January 10, 2016, Mr. William Rivera, 60, of Hoboken, succumbed to his injuries, after being struck by a car at the intersection of Observer Highway and Bloomfield Street in Hoboken last Tuesday evening, January 3rd. Mr. Rivera remained in critical condition at the Jersey City Medical Center since being brought there by EMS on the night of the crash.

Mr. Rivera was hit while crossing Observer Highway by a 2016 Jeep Compass that was heading westbound. The Jeep was driven Mirza Riysath of Valley Stream NY. Riysath remained at the scene and is cooperating with Sheriff's Crash Investigators.

The crash remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Crash Investigation Unit."
