

Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari on Critical Accident in Jersey City

JERSEY CITY, NJ - Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari regarding a critical accident which occurred yesterday morning on Kennedy Blvd., in Jersey City.

“The driver of the 2010 Nissan Maxima which was involved in a critical accident yesterday morning in Jersey City, Kenneth Franklin, 24, of Jersey City, has been issued summonses for: Driving While Intoxicated, Speeding and Careless Driving. He still remains in critical condition at the Jersey City Medical Center.

The front passenger of the vehicle, Isiah Dixon, 25, of Jersey City, remains unconscious and in critical condition. The third passenger, Kenneth Brendan Spann, 25 of St. Louis, MO., received minor injuries and was released from the hospital yesterday.

Crash Investigators have determined Franklin was driving his vehicle more than double the posted 25 MPH speed limit and struck the tree at approximately 60 mph.”
