

Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari On Bicyclist Struck by Vehicle on Tonnelle Avenue

JERSEY CITY, NJ - Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari regarding a bicyclist that had been struck by a vehicle on Tonnelle Avenue on Sunday afternoon.

“Wilfredo Martinez, 19, of Concord Street in Jersey City, who was struck by a vehicle on Sunday afternoon on Tonnelle Avenue in North Bergen, was charged today with Possession of Marijuana. After investigators found marijuana in a backpack he was wearing the night of the crash.

Also, the driver of the car, Jonathan Kusakabe, of North Bergen, was issued a summons for driving with a suspended license. The owner of the Dodge charger, Somayah Loyola, 25, of North Bergen, was also issued a summons for allowing a suspended driver to operate a vehicle. Kusakabe is Loyola's boyfriend.

Martinez remains hospitalized in stable condition with multiple fractures. Crash Investigators have determined that the bicycle that Martinez was riding did not have brakes. He is very lucky to be alive.”
