

Hudson County Sheriff's Office's Thanksgiving Drunk/Impaired Driving Crackdown a Success

JERSEY CITY NJ – As part of a county wide crackdown on drunk and impaired driving during Thanksgiving weekend, Hudson County Frank Schillari reported 6 total arrests and dozens of citations (see chart below)

6 - Total Arrests
2 – DWI
64 - Traffic Summonses
7 - Vehicles impounded for being unregistered.

Breakdown of the most serious traffic violations:

7 - Careless driving
2- Speeding
3 - Failure to Observe Traffic Signal (Red Light)
1 - Improper Passing
3 - Failure to Stop at Stop Sign
2 - Failure to wear Seatbelt
4- Unlicensed Drivers
