**JERSEY CITY** -- A recent warrant sweep by the Hudson County Sheriff's Office resulted in the arrest of 25 people for failing to pay child support, drug charges and other offenses.

## Sheriff's Office warrant sweep nabs 16

The Hudson County Sheriff's Office arrested 16 people during a warrant sweep dubbed Operation Safer Streets last week including a fugitive from New York who was arrested after a traffic stop.

Others arrested on child support warrants are Bayonne residents Douglas Pipher, 37; Nestor Mejias, 43, and Michael Caballero, 42, as well as Thomas McHugh, 43, and Edwin Colon of Weehawken, Juan Morales, 28, of Union City, Emile Bustamante, 32, of West New York, and Errol Alfaro, 34 and Deyvi Bueno, 27, of North Bergen, Schillari said.

Arrested on drug related warrants were Jersey City residents, Jovan Amiker, 39 and Nathanile Kitchens, 46, as well as Leverne Ford, 54, of New York, Schillari said.

Also arrested was Taksim Chowdhury, 29, of Albertson, N.Y. - burglary; Elena Ratti, 38, of Lincoln Park - theft; Robert Stone, 33, of Ewing - aggravated assault, Schillari said.

Out of state residents arrested were Jorge Prez, 54, of Ohio - unlawful possession of a weapon; Milton Tavaras, 29, of Florida - burglary; and Hector Medina, 29, of the Bronx - conspiracy, Schillari said.
