## **Hudson County Sheriff Frank Schillari on Fatal Hit and Run Accident on Broadway Ave., in Bayonne**

JERSEY CITY, NJ - Statement from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari regarding hit and run accident on Broadway Avenue in Bayonne last night.

"At approximately 8:00 PM last night the Hudson County Sheriff's Office and the Bayonne Police Department responded to a call of a pedestrian struck by a vehicle.

Mary Koszyk, 72, of Bayonne was walking North on Broadway Avenue, when she was struck by a 2002 Ford pickup truck, driven by Nicholas Flett, 24, of Bayonne, that was traveling eastbound on 32nd Street. Following the accident, Mr. Flett fled the scene of the crash.

Mrs. Koszyk succumbed to her injuries at the Jersey City Medical Center.

Mr. Flett turned himself in to the Bayonne Police this morning, in addition his driver's license was suspended at the time of the accident.

He has been charged with leaving the scene of a fatal accident, causing death while driving on a suspended driver's license and possession of cocaine.

The crash still remains under investigation by the Hudson County Sheriff's Office."
