

Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari On Critical Accident on Kennedy Blvd in Jersey City

JERSEY CITY, NJ - Statement from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari regarding a critical accident on Kennedy Blvd., in Jersey City.

“This morning at approximately 2:20 AM, a Hudson County Sheriff's patrol car was travelling northbound on Kennedy Blvd., near Stuyvesant Ave., in Jersey City, when a blue 2010 Nissan Maxima that was travelling at a high rate of speed, heading south, lost control and crossed into the northbound lanes.

The Maxima careened out of control, went onto the sidewalk and hit a tree and two parked cars. Part of the tree fell, striking a third parked car.

The maxima narrowly missed hitting the Sheriff's patrol car. The Sheriff's Officer immediately radioed for assistance and rendered what aid he could.

The driver and front seat passenger were critically injured and had to be rescued from the wreckage by the Jersey City Fire Department, they were transported by Jersey City EMS to the Jersey City Medical Center where they remain in critical condition.

Names cannot be released pending notification of family. The Sheriff's Office Crash Investigation Unit is actively investigating the crash.”
