I. Purpose:

To establish procedures governing interactions between Hudson County Sheriff's Office personnel and federal authorities involved in civil immigration enforcement in compliance with **NJ Attorney General Law Enforcement Directive 2018-6 v2.0**

II. Policy:

The Hudson County Sheriff's Office shall uphold and enforce all local, state, and federal laws, including but not limited to the State and Federal Constitution. Enforcement shall be without regard to immigration status and will abide with the NJ Attorney General Law Enforcement Directive No. 2018-6 V2.0: Directive Strengthening Trust Between Law Enforcement and Immigrant Communities. Our priority as always is keeping our respective community safe within the confines of the law.

III. Authorized Actions:

The Hudson County Sheriff's Office incorporates by reference the NJ Attorney General Law Enforcement Directive 2018-6 v2.0 (attached hereto).

IV. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Detainers & Holds

ICE detainers and administrative warrants are civil requests and shall not be treated as judicial orders or warrants.

V. Booking Information:

Personnel may collect information required for booking, classification, and state reporting systems, including place of birth and country of citizenship. Such collection does not authorize civil immigration enforcement.

VI. 287(g) Agreements:

The Hudson County Sheriff's Office shall not enter, renew, extend, or exercise authority under any 287(g) agreement.

VII. Documentation & Reporting:

The Hudson County Sheriff's Office shall comply with all reporting requirements as stated within Directive 2018-6 v2.0.

VIII. Training:

Annual training shall be provided in accordance with Directive 2018-6 v2.0 requirements, exceptions, consent procedures, and supervisory review responsibilities.

IX. All members of the Sheriff's Office will take cognizance of the above, and all records will be so noted.
