

Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari On Truck Involved in Accident in Jersey City

JERSEY CITY, NJ - Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari regarding a truck that was involved in an accident in Jersey City today.

“Today at approximately 12:15 pm my Officers responded to a report of a Chevrolet flatbed truck, with a billboard sign affixed to the back, which had struck the N.J. Transit Train bridge.

The bridge goes over Marin Blvd., between 18th Street & Observer Hgwy., on the Jersey City - Hoboken Border.

The Driver, Herman Perry, 32, of North Las Vegas, Nevada suffered a head injury and pains to his chest and was transported by Jersey City EMS to the Jersey City Medical Center in stable condition. The injuries are considered non-life threatening.

The truck was stuck under the bridge for approximately an hour and thirty minutes before it was towed away.

Engineering Officials from NJ Transit inspected the bridge to make sure there was no structural damage.

No summonses were issued.”
